# I Spy nine patch

*Inspired by overflowing bins of novelty fabrics.*

Choose nine bright and colourful fabrics with an image(s) that will be fun for a child to find. The 9 fabrics can focus on one colour family OR 5 dark and 4 light fabrics OR simply a selection of what is on hand. A focus square for the middle may be pleasing to the eye. Don't overthink it! Have fun.




Finished Block: 9 1/2 inch (with outer seam allowances)

**Red**


From each of 9 bright novelty fabrics cut a 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square. Fussy cut the square to showcase image.

**Block Assembly:** Use scant 1/4 inch seams.


Rows 1 and 3: Stitch 3 squares together in a row. Press seam to outside.



Row 2: Same as above except Press seam to centre.



Stitch rows together matching seams. Press seams to outside and you're done!
